The Hunterdon County Teen Arts Master Sheet for Visual Arts Entries completed accurately is due at Deer Path Park on **Monday, May 17th after 2pm** along with the pieces to be hung and displayed. **Please bring T pins and Push Pins to hang your 2D pieces.** There will be tables for the 3D pieces. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HANGING, DISPLAYING, AND TAKE DOWN OF YOUR STUDENT'S WORK.** Visual Arts includes 2-D, 3-D and photography.

Note: a \$10.00 student fee is charged if student is home schooled, school district is not participating or attends a school outside of Hunterdon County but lives in Hunterdon County.

1. Students in grades 7 – 12 may exhibit.
2. **Only 1 entry per student is allowed in each area: 2D, 3D, and Photography.**
3. Please submit ORIGINAL artwork only-as **copies are not eligible for State Teen Arts Exhibits.**
4. Each entry must be labeled using the tags provided. Tags must include Artist's Name, School, Grade, Age, Art Teacher, Title and Medium. Please ...**TITLE ALL ART WORK!**
5. All work must be suitable for public exhibition before audiences of all ages. (Please utilize your school districts Appropriateness Policy.)
6. **Mounting Instructions:** All 2-D pieces must be equipped for secure hanging. They must be matted and may be framed, or mounted. Hanging apparatus cannot consist of string or wire affixed to the work with tape, which is not sturdy. Do not use glass on framed pieces; Plexiglas however is acceptable.
7. Teachers complete this one application form representing all their proposed students.
8. The Hunterdon County Teen Arts Master Sheet for Visual Arts Entries must accompany your pieces to the Deer Path Park for safety and tracking reasons.
9. Several pieces will be selected to represent Hunterdon County at the State Teen Arts Festival in May. Two pieces will be selected for New Jersey State Teens Arts Touring Arts Exhibit. Students who do not wish to have their pieces considered for other venues, must state so on the identifying tag.
10. Students are encouraged to take photographs or slides of their work PRIOR to the submission if needed for their portfolio.
11. PLEASE provide a parent or teacher chaperone with each group of ten students.
12. PLEASE provide your students with a Student Identification Badge complete with their name and school, to be worn in plain site on their street clothes during the Festival.
13. **Please email a provide a list of students who would like their artwork critiqued and a time frame that students will have available for them to be critiqued.**
